



MMTA2 Research Paper Description:

The research project will be based on a market of your (or your group's) choice. You will conduct a long-term cycles analysis on that market. It can be any cycle, but the cycle must be over ~50-weeks in length, and you must provide the dates of the highs, lows, percentage increase and decrease (preferably in table format like we did in Course One), and the number of months or weeks that each cycle rose or fell.

You will need to identify the dates of long-term and intermediate-term cycles (at least 50-week cycles). You will be asked to create a table like we have done for the 18- and 4-year cycles in the DJIA in Classes 3 and 4 (date of beginning trough, crest and ending trough), showing the length of the cycle, length of the time from start to crest, and length of time from crest to trough, plus percent of gains and losses in each. You will then need to write a summary of results that each member has contributed to and agrees with the paper.

The paper should be about 3-8 pages in length, which would include chart(s) of your selected market. In your group, someone will have to be assigned (by each of you) to create the table and someone else assigned to write the report. Might be a good idea to have each member identify the dates and prices to make sure everyone is on the same page. You will need to have Skype or Zoom meetings (or some other way to meet virtually) with one another.
